Collage Animals: Cats, Dogs, Eagles, Owls

This class is for mommy or daddy and me, grandparent and me, or your favorite adult and me! Kids from 8 to 100 are invited to the Pocatello Art Center for a fun Saturday, June 30th from 10 – 3 p.m. Bring a sack lunch and a drink.

We will spend the morning using oil pastels in your favorite colors to make beautiful and colorful backgrounds on a large piece of paper. The students will spread out on the floor or tables and scribble to the sound of fast and slow music using large arm motions that cross over the body. This type of motion crosses from the right side of the body to the left using both hemispheres of the brain since each side control one side of the body. It is relaxing and freeing! When finished the kids will paint over their scribbles with water colors, tempera paint, and India ink exploring different ways paint resists or does not resist the crayon.

Next step is to make strips of paper from their paintings and glue the strips onto another piece of paper. They will make eyes and noses of the animal they want and outline them with paint. Students will be invited to display their work in the classroom during the First Friday Art walk in July, 2018.
