Malynda Cooper was born in 1977 and grew up in Provo, Utah, surrounded by art. She creates sculptures that portray emotions through movement and expression. Clay is her main medium for creation, but often the final result of her work is in another material, such as plaster, metal, or stone. Malynda graduated from Brigham Young University in 2000, with a BFA in figure sculpture. She then went on to get her MFA from the Academy of Art University in San Francisco in 2017.

She has won several local and regional awards, including 1st place in the PACAF sculpture competition and the 2016 scholarship award from the International Portrait Society. Some of her sculptures can be seen in the private collections: the Heller Rose Gardens in Stanwood, Washington; the Museum of Clean in Pocatello; and Idaho State University in Pocatello. She currently shows her work at Gate City Fine Art Gallery in Pocatello, Idaho.

We are inviting all photographers to submit their best images to our juried show. This is designed as a forum for the public to see the best photographic work of our area. We want to honor that work. All images are invited to compete.

RULES:

- 1 - There is no limit to the number of images that may be entered.
- 2 - The entry fee is \$10.00 per image.
- 3 - All prints must be framed, and **ready to hang**, or they will not be accepted. Wire only, 4" from top.
- 4 - Name, title & price **must** be on the back.
- 5 - No name will be allowed on the front of the image while judging. If your print is signed, we will cover your name before judging.
- 6 - Due to limited space prints & frame may be no larger than 35"X 40".
- 7 - No entries will be accepted by mail.
- 8 - Due to limited space or **content** it is possible some of the prints will not be accepted or hung. NO REFUNDS.
- 9 - The entry form must be returned with your total fee, payable Portneuf Valley Photographic Society. Check or cash only.
- 10 - There will be 8 Divisions:
 - 1 - ANIMAL KINGDOM.
 - 2 - BOTANICAL
 - 3 - BLACK & WHITE
 - 4 - OBVIOUS MANIPULATION

GUIDELINES FOR THE ANNUAL JUDGED SHOW
(See your Directory for more details)

1. You may enter up to 3 items at **\$10.00** per item.
2. The 3 items can be any combination of categories, and/or levels at \$10.00 each.
3. **Paintings/art cannot be larger than 40" wide including the frame. The Gallery Committee will not accept any art that is larger than those dimensions.**
All art must be the artist's original work.
4. All hanging art work must be framed and ready for hanging. No gator hook hangers that screw into the top of the frame. A tight wire attached on each side 3-4 inches from the top of the frame works very well for our hanging system.
5. No work from copyrighted material is acceptable.
6. Work should have been completed within the last 3 years.
7. All art must be identified on the Art Center card with artist name and title of art; any work for sale should be marked with a price on the Art Center card.
8. Identifiable signatures on the front of paintings/other art will be covered during the judging process.
9. Work that has won in past PAC Art Shows cannot be entered.
10. Gallery wrapped canvases are acceptable, but must be painted on all sides and meet the same criteria listed in #3 of these Guidelines.
11. There will be an additional entry fee of **\$25.00** on each piece of artwork submitted by non-members.

LEVELS

- Level I Amateur - a beginning artist. Class work is acceptable but must be original work of the artist.*
- Level II Intermediate - an artist who has worked independently in a medium over a period of time, has had training in the form of classes, private lessons or workshops, and may sell their work occasionally.*
- Level III Advanced Intermediate - an artist who may sell and display and who has had extensive training and / or worked independently in an art medium on regular basis.*
- Level IV Advanced / Professional - an artist who has received awards in other shows: one who sells their work and/or teaches.*
