GUIDELINES FOR THE ANNUAL JUDGED SHOW
(See your Directory for more details)

1. You may enter up to 3 items at **\$10.00** per item.
2. The 3 items can be any combination of categories, and/or levels at \$10.00 each.
3. **Paintings/art cannot be larger than 40" wide including the frame. The Gallery Committee will not accept any art that is larger than those dimensions.**
All art must be the artist's original work.
4. All hanging art work must be framed and ready for hanging. No gator hook hangers that screw into the top of the frame. A tight wire attached on each side 3-4 inches from the top of the frame works very well for our hanging system.
5. No work from copyrighted material is acceptable.
6. Work should have been completed within the last 3 years.
7. All art must be identified on the Art Center card with artist name and title of art; any work for sale should be marked with a price on the Art Center card.
8. Identifiable signatures on the front of paintings/other art will be covered during the judging process.
9. Work that has won in past PAC Art Shows cannot be entered.
10. Gallery wrapped canvases are acceptable, but must be painted on all sides and meet the same criteria listed in #3 of these Guidelines.
11. There will be an additional entry fee of **\$25.00** on each piece of artwork submitted by non-members.

LEVELS

- Level I Amateur - a beginning artist. Class work is acceptable but must be original work of the artist.**
- Level II Intermediate - an artist who has worked independently in a medium over a period of time, has had training in the form of classes, private lessons or workshops, and may sell their work occasionally.**
- Level III Advanced Intermediate - an artist who may sell and display and who has had extensive training and / or worked independently in an art medium on regular basis.**
- Level IV Advanced / Professional - an artist who has received awards in other shows: one who sells their work and/or teaches.**

Malynda graduated from Brigham Young University in 2000, with a BFA in figure sculpture. She then went on to get her MFA from the Academy of Art University in San Francisco in 2017.

She has won several local and regional awards, including 1st place in the PACAF sculpture competition and the 2016 scholarship award from the International Portrait Society. Some of her sculptures can be seen in the private collections: the Heller Rose Gardens in Stanwood, Washington; the Museum of Clean in Pocatello; and Idaho State University in Pocatello. She currently shows her work at Gate City Fine Art Gallery in Pocatello, Idaho.

Art Foundations is dedicated to the individual artistic enrichment, education and to developing the capabilities of artists and aspiring artists by teaching the vital fundamentals of fine art.

What is Art Foundations? Art Foundations is a structured program designed to take you, the student, from the level you are at, to more advanced levels in painting and drawing. You will have the opportunity to develop drawing and painting skills through ongoing classes while gaining sound training in the vital foundational principles that apply equally to art in any of its medium forms. Currently there are available Art Foundations I and Foundations II classes along with several two day intensive learning workshops during the summer months. More advanced classes will be added in the near future. Classes are structured in a semester format.

What Art Foundations has to offer? Vital principles in painting needed in any fine art medium are taught. Through studio time, assignments, videos and readings and personal instruction, the 5 keys to creating successful paintings such as design, drawing, value, color and technique are taught. You will also gain confidence in the painting process. Art Foundations is ideal for you if you want a different path other than traditional college campus to learn to paint and draw.

Who is the instructor? Danene Taysom has taught art classes and workshops for many years at the Pocatello Art Center along with private and semi-private classes in her studio.

She began her art education at Brigham Young University-Idaho. She received her degree in Interior Design, excelling in design, interior architectural renderings and presentations. After graduation she worked at several prominent architectural firms where she professionally used both her design and art skills. For more than two decades she has focused on her love, oil painting and drawing! She has studied for many years under the renowned Russian master painter and teacher, Ovanes Berberian.

Danene is a member Inspirational Art Association and Alliance of Covenant Artists where she has displayed her work at many of their juried shows. She has also received an "Award of Distinction" from the Alliance of Covenant Artists for her award-winning original painting "Roses in C Major".
